Through the Children's Bureau's **Community Partners for Child Safety** program, case workers will conduct weekly visits to help parents identify and meet specific goals to stabilize families and alleviate stress that may put kids at risk. Goals range from finding safe, affordable housing to seeking employment or addressing addictions or mental health concerns.

- Eligibility requirements for the **Community Partners for Child Safety** program:
  - Families with children 0-17
  - Families that are not actively involved with the Department of Child Services or Healthy Families
